MNGO MEETING (Mother NGO)

13th Feb 2023: Mother GO Human Aid Society called an important meeting of its Group members at Human Aid Society Head office Baramulla and this meeting was held under the chair of Haji Qaramat Qayoom Patron HAS and various Social Issues-/ challenges where thoroughly discussed and it was unanimously decided that all the NGOs working under the MNGO Banner will try to launch a result oriented campaign with a joint slogan **"Social Reforms and our Responsibilities"** to curb the growing trends of drugs and suicidal tendency through a common platform and in this regard an inaugural program of the said campaign will be held on 18th March 2023 (Saturday) 10.30 am in Govt Boys Degree College Baramulla.



Seminar 'Social Reform and Our Responsibility'

18th March 2023: Continuing its combat to eradicate the social evils eating at the core of society, Human Aid Society a (Mother NGO) in collaboration with its partner non-governmental organization (NGOs) Jammu and Kashmir Yateem Foundation, Human Welfare Voluntary organisation, Gaints Grou of Baramulla and Karwaan Imdaad organized a daylong seminar on theme 'Social Reforms and Our Responsibility' at auditorium of Government Boys Degree College Baramulla on Saturday in north Kashmir's Baramulla district.



Former Chief Justice Jammu and Kashmir UT and Ladakh UT, **Justice Ali Mohammad Magrey** was the **Chief guest** while Deputy Commissioner Baramulla **Dr Syed Sehrish Asgar** was guest of honour and Principal Degree College Baramulla Prof. Mohammad Dr Farooq Rather presided over the function. While addressing to the to the audience which include people from cross section of society in jam-packed auditorium, chief guest Former Chief Justice Jammu and Kashmir UT and Ladakh Justice Ali Mohammad Magray said, "It is collective responsibility of every individual in the society to fight against the social evils and more responsibility lies on the shoulders of parents and religious clerics, teachers and social activists to eradicate the menaces as society is witnessing steep rise in suicide tendencies and drug abuse ."



Urging parents not to put their children in rat race or competitions which lead to extreme depression, Justice Ali Mohammad Magray said, “We are responsible for increasing the depression level among our children for we are putting them in such competitions which are beyond their potential level.”

Speaking on the occasion Deputy Commissioner Baramulla Dr Syed Sehrish Asgar said that stress level high in kids due to studies as we have put them in competition and there is performance pressure on them. “We have to realize that every individual is born with special abilities and capabilities but we put ourselves in competitions of achievers which leads to depression. We must not give space to negative thinking, we have to face and fight the challenges,” she added.

She added that the administration is taking all possible efforts to do away with social evils including drug menace but all individuals have to join the government in fight against social evils.

Earlier, renowned Islamic scholar Nisar-ul-haq Nadvi said, “For social reform we need to change food for thought like education and social atmosphere because thinking shapes our deeds. Every individual must understand his/her aim of life as per religious perspectives.”

Head Gaint International Jagdev Singh expressed his concern over growing immorality, social evils, drug addiction and suicide tendencies among the young generation in Kashmir.

Renowned psychologist and former Dean Kashmir University’s Psychology Dr. Abdul Gani Madhoosh said, “It is bar fact the that social evils are increasing with every passing day and there is no spiritual power behind it but we as members of society are responsible and need introspection to enlighten our conscience.” He urged people not to misuse sophisticated gadgets like mobile phones, internet and other unnecessary apparatus.



Earlier, Chairman Human Aid Society Bashir Ahmed Mir while welcoming the guests said, “Human Aid Society in collaboration with its partner NGOs launched this campaign to make awareness among the society that there is rise in social evils like drug abuse and suicide tendencies. We have to work together as our society need moral and value reform given the increase in varied social evils and menaces.”



ZERO HUNGER (1st Phase RAMZAN PROGRAMME 2023):

22nd March 2023: Human Aid Society in collaboration with Kashmir Development Foundation -UK (KDF UK) distribute Food kits among fifty-50 deserving families under its Humanitarian Aid Program "Zero Hunger" Program (phase 1st) , Consisting poor, widow ,orphan or below poverty line from various tehsils like that of Baramulla, Narwaw, Boniyar and Dangiwachha .This program was organised so that these families do not face any sort of problem and they could keep Fasting without facing any hindrance. In this connection Fifty-50 identified families (phase 1st) were provided those kits having all the essential commodities for one month. In today's occasion these families were made to interact with Jammu and Kashmir Police DSP Mr Naveed Qazi who is presently serving (Probationary) as SHO Police station Baramulla.

24th March 2023: Chairman Human Aid Society Bashir Ah Mir distributed 73 (Seventy-three) food kits among various families who are living under pathetic conditions in Tehsil Kreeri, Pattan, Baramulla and Wagoora. It is pertinent to mention here that Zero Hunger program is fully supported by KDF- UK and in this regard the Human Aid Society has completed its Ramadan distribution program task for District Baramulla while in the organization will soon distribute the same among its identified beneficiaries of Jammu Province.
