Monthly Grocery Support Program for Widows

In the month of October 2025, Human Aid Society successfully carried out the distribution of daily essential food items among 100 widows belonging to the poorest families of District Baramulla. The distribution was organized at Dak Bungalow, Baramulla, ensuring dignity, transparency, and systematic delivery of assistance.

The selection and verification of beneficiaries were conducted through an online registration process, facilitated by a dedicated software system developed by Human Aid Society's international funding partner, Muslim Aid Australia (MAA). This digital mechanism ensured fairness, accuracy, and accountability in beneficiary identification.



The widows who received support under this initiative are enrolled in the Monthly Grocery Support Program of Muslim Aid Australia, through which they receive essential food items every month. This assistance is aimed at addressing food insecurity and supporting vulnerable women who are the sole breadwinners of their families.

The beneficiaries expressed deep gratitude to Human Aid Society and Muslim Aid Australia for the consistent monthly support, stating that this assistance significantly eases their daily hardships and helps them manage household needs with dignity.

Human Aid Society reaffirmed its commitment to continue this support without interruption for one full year, from August 2025 to July 2026, for the identified widows. The organization emphasized that sustained assistance is crucial for stabilizing the lives of vulnerable families and enabling widows to focus on the well-being and future of their children.

This initiative reflects Human Aid Society's ongoing dedication to social protection, women empowerment, and humanitarian relief, carried out in collaboration with international partners to uplift the most marginalized sections of society.
