Jammu & Kashmir State continues to remain disturbed, because of the three-decade old turmoil, which has been taking a heavy toll of life and property, besides serious damage, in its aftermath, to the social fabric of the state. The State has witnessed a number of causalities in the years 2008 & 2016. This has created manifold challenges for social service organizations like Human Aid Society. In the past few years, Human Aid Society has worked very hard to develop a better understanding of the education system.
