#### 2023-WINTER AID PROJECT CONCLUDED.

**27**<sup>th</sup> **Dec 2023:** Human Aid Society by the support of Malaysian based donor organization ILTIZAM RELIEF SOCIETY had completed its WINTER AID distribution wherein 500 most deserved families have been covered from district Kupwara, Bandipora and Baramulla as identified by the volunteers of the organization, after a proper door to door verification. The poorest of poor families who were covered, were suffering during this harsh winter.

In PHASE-I, the distribution started in late Oct-2023 initiated from tehsil MACHIL and tehsil LOLAB of district Kupwara wherein 100 families received the Winter Aid Kits.

Also, during this phase, the distribution was held in district Bandipora and in few tehsils of district Baramulla and covered more 200 families.



In PHASE-II, distribution was held in early Nov-2023 and 100 families living in miserable conditions were covered from district Bandipora and Baramulla.

Now, in conclusion period of PHASE-III, another distribution program was held on 27th Dec 2023 at old age home of Human Aid Society located at Fatehpora Baramulla in presence of DYSP J&K Police HQ Baramulla Mr. Syed Aijaz sab for another remaining 100 families who were pertaining from different tehsils of District Baramulla.
