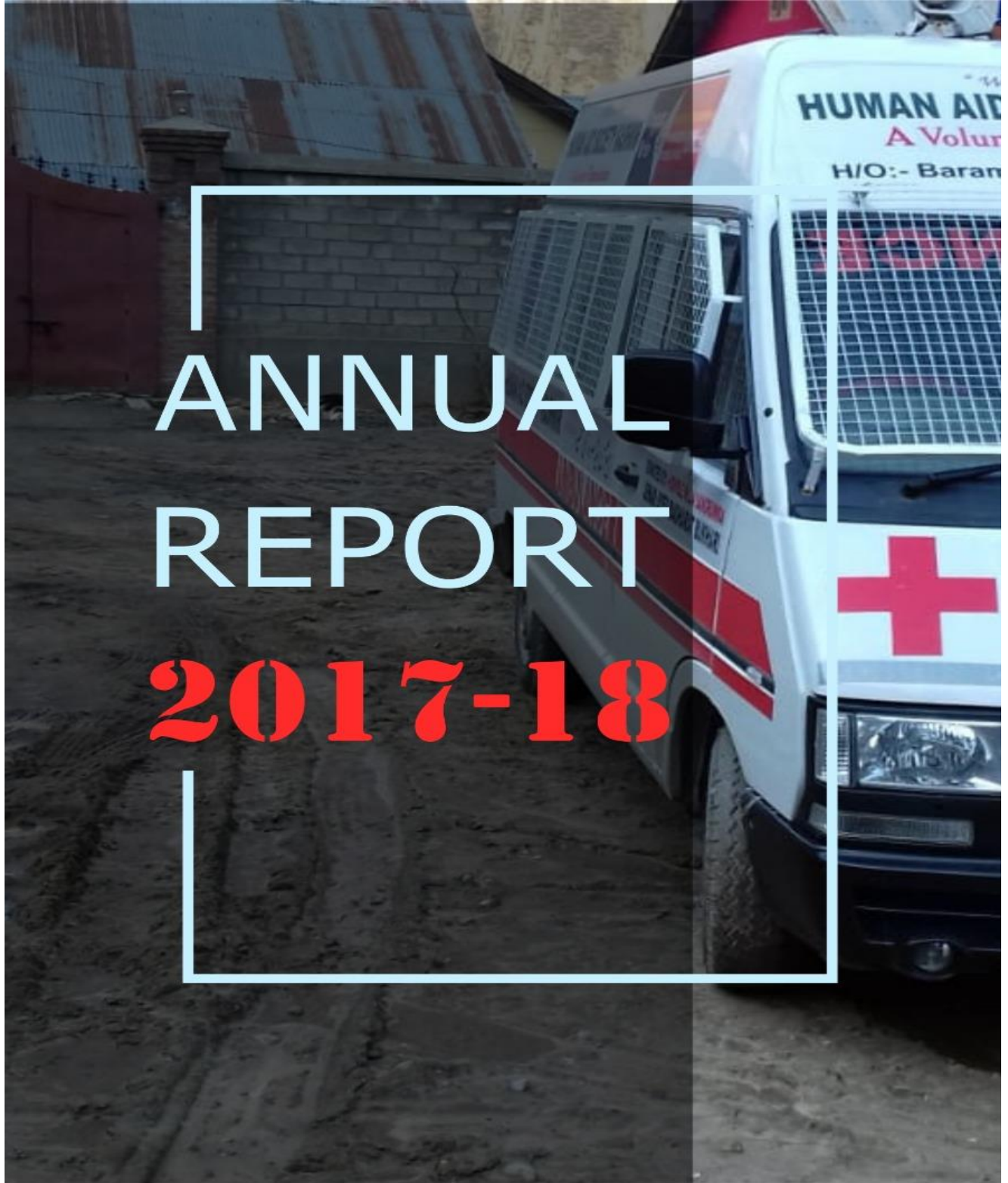

INTRODUCTION

Human Aid Society is a nonprofit organization (registered as a society with the Registrar of Societies) set up in 2000, with the objective of providing a helping hand to people affected by the violence in the strife-torn valley. The focus has been on providing education, mental health counseling to women and children, who have been the worst victims of turmoil, relief and rehabilitation to various sections of the society who are severely challenged by physical disability and/or economic deprivation. With a team of dedicated

trustees, volunteers and staff, the Human Aid Society has extended its activities in the North Kashmir. Coverage under various charitable activities is tabled as under:

RELIEF & REHABILITATION

Relief to Victims of natural calamities:



Human Aid Society also provides aid to the victims of natural calamities like floods, earthquake, fire etc. During the year 17-18 there wasn't any huge calamity but relief was provided to few victims of fire incidents.

Assistance for Orphan girl Marriages:



Human Aid Society also provides aid (cash and or kind) to the orphan and other needy girls who have nobody to look after at their marriage. Over last 10 years almost 50 girls have been provided with the assistance. During the year 2017-18, eight 8 poor and orphan girls were provided Cash assistance ,wedding dress and basic marriage amenities needed on such occasion.

Aid to Chronic Patients:

From past few years Human Aid Society has provided cash assistance to almost 80 patients suffering from different types of ailments. A cash disbursement of almost Rs- 60470/ was made under this programm
