## ZERO HUNGER PROGRAMME under Ramadan Fasting project of (MAA)

## Introduction:

As the holy month of Ramadan approached, the Human Aid Society in Collaboration with Muslim aid Austria (MAA) launched a noble initiative aimed at supporting underprivileged families by providing essential food supplies. The fortnightly Food Kit Distribution Program, conducted a week before the onset of Ramadan, aimed to ensure that widows, poor families, destitute individuals, and differently-abled persons would not be suffer for feeding their family. Each distributed food kit contained Flour, pulses, cooking oil, sugar, namkeen & salt Tea, chilli/ Termic powder, dates and other essential items, ensuring that families could observe Ramadan without food insecurity.

### Scope and Outreach

Under the supervision of the Secretary of the organisation (HAS) along with area heads and a dedicated team of Members/volunteers, the program successfully reached three districts of North Kashmir, covering:

In total, 1,500 families, comprising around 6491 individuals, benefitted from this initiative particularly in remote and border areas such as Uri, Bandipora, Kupwara, and Kandi areas of Baramulla and the initiative of distribution was taken on 15th Feb 2025 and was concluded on 27th Feb 2025.

***The far-flung villages were given priorities for this project. The area includes Hamam Markoote, Kindi Baba Reshi, Sultan Diki, Hakapathri, and Gooriwan of Baramulla; Tangtari and Athwatoos of Bandipora; Kalaroos and Lalpora of Kupwara.***



### Impact

The Muslim Aid Austria (MAA) Ramadan 2025 initiative has once again reinforced its humanitarian commitment by reaching 1,500 families in 20 Tehsils of North Kashmir's three districts (Baramulla, Kupwara, Bandipora) and spent over INR 47,40,147 on this project. The program not only provided material support but also strengthened the spirit of compassion, unity, and generosity within the society.
