From Chairman's Desk

Dear Readers. I would like to give you a brief introduction about the work done by the Human Aid Society and the policy it has formulated since the foundation of the organization was laid in November 1999 and till date this organization has helped hundreds of orphans and poor people. This organization tries its level best in full filling the educational requirements of its sponsor wards but also organized constantly the carrier counselling class for them and by the grace of God many of these children will reach their destination. Apart from this, though the financial resource of this organization was not stable but still took pride in helping the widows, sick, elderly and poor people whom they found in need. If we look at the performance of the previous years and the support projects of this organization from 1999 to 2021, the organization has focused mostly of its efforts on charity. This organization has realized that no nation or country can be taken over overnight, nor can the condition of its people change unless a planned strategy can be implemented and employment opportunities are created for their youths as it has seen that charity work is necessary to relieve the people from difficulties temporarily and rehabilitation can be its permanent solution.

Dear friends, our experience of 25 years in this field has taught us well that our society has become so accustomed and our people want to take up professions which are directly affecting their children as they are now used to being able to provide for themselves without the risks of work.

Friends when such conditions or trends change in the society, it becomes the responsibility of the social organization working in the society to formulate a policy within themselves that will keep charity as a part of it. While they can work on some projects for public bids so that the public can be fully supported, especially in order to deal with unemployment, it is the responsibility of the organizations/ institutions to find new ways and save and secure their young generation.

The members of this organization must also know that for the Sustainable development of the nation, it has become necessary for the person to keep a close eye on the environment so that a clean environment can be created. In this regard the organization has taken an initiative to save the environment and planted thousands of saplings in various, School, forest lands, public parks and at banks of streams and rivers and create resources for future generations to breathe a sigh of relief.

The members of Human Aid Society also felt strongly that to deal with the current situation in the society, this organization has formulated a new policy to provide employment to the unemployed youth, especially boys and girls. and in this regard, the Human Society in the year 2022 established various dried vegetable and Fruit processing units and cutting and tailoring centers through which not only the employment resources can be created for the unemployment youths but also agricultural and horticultural sector of Kashmir will get boost with the financial support of the Australian Embassy High Commission New Delhi and Kashmir Development Foundation U-K

I would personally request those people who live in villages, towns and cities to establish their local Bait-u-al -Mals and help their needy people as they found eligible for their assistance. We believe that by working in this way not only the deserved person will be treated well but all those persons/ groups will be punished whom people are found collecting donations wrongly in their names.

FOOD KITS DISTRIBUTION

WHY ZERO HUNGER PROJECT IS RELEVANT FOR JAMMU AND KASHMIR

“ZERO HUNGER” is among one of the sustainable goals as set by the UNO and Human Aid Society practicing the UNO charter in Jammu and Kashmir as world knows that J&K has a unique geographical position from other states of India as the state consists of three major regions, JAMMU, LADAKH and KASHMIR. The Jammu province is considered hot, LADAKH is coldest hilly region and Kashmir is known as a beautiful valley surrounded by mountains on all four sides. The Jammu province is all time connected with the other states of India and it is also close to the central capital as compared to Ladakh and Kashmir provinces. The road and air traffic connectivity of Jammu region uninterrupted round the year while the road and air links connecting the Ladakh and Kashmir are often disconnected for weeks and months due to its bad weather conditions. Most of the area of Ladakh and Kashmir province is hilly where people have to face problems due to lack of communication and other basic facilities.

The Kashmir economy boosted fruit industry of Jammu and Kashmir is becoming also victim of this weather, and due to the closure of the National Highway Road vegetables and fruits loaded in the vehicles are spoiled on the way before reaching its targeted destinations. The prices of the ration exported from the other parts of the country also seen to be skyrocketing and the poor people are not able to bear it and become victims of hunger.



People of the whole world are aware of the fact that Jammu and Kashmir has been suffering from almost last 35 years and due to which not only our young generation has lost their lives but also a long line of widows and orphans has stood up and enmity between the neighboring countries lot of people living on these places lose their lives and property due to their relentless firing and mortar shillings happened on these borders round the year. The orphan children and widows of the affected families are facing difficulties to get two meals a day they are sometimes fed-up with the starvation and reach the verge of suicide or choosing an illegal path for themselves. Young generation living elsewhere in the Kashmir felt in depression due to lack of employment

resources and various other reasons and mostly these youths are involving themselves in using of narcotic drugs or becoming the drug peddlers. National and International Organizations are not very inclined to work in this Kashmir for restoring its glory which may be due to several reasons and in these situations the local NGO's is the only ray of hope for these hopeless people but it is worth to mentioning here that the local NGO's do not have enough financial recourse to help these people to any extent.

Human Aid Society despite its limited financial resources consistently deliver ration kits under its **ZERO HUNGER PROJECT** and in financial year 2022-2023 the organization covered near about **150 widow/ Orphans** headed families and dropped ration kits at their door steps by the members/ volunteers of this organization after every four months which is enough to feed four to five family members for the said period. Besides it the organization cover **100 more families** living under below poverty line in the similar pattern and all this become possible by the financial support of an international organization KDF-UK, and the curative of this Programme is purely that no human being says goodbye to his/ her life due to starvation.

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT UNDER SAFE PROJECT

In Year 2022, Human Aid Society has introduced a new concept under the theme of "Sustenance Through Affordable Farming and Entrepreneurship (SAFE) by the financial support of **Australian High Commission New Delhi** to empower the unemployed women folk. The project concept was also to boost the agricultural and horticultural industry of Jammu and Kashmir and to save the fruits and vegetables which are perished here due to various circumstances. The special feature of this project was to create a ray of hope among the farmers here so that they can play their key role in increasing the economy of Jammu and Kashmir by cultivating more fruits and vegetables, besides it to improve scientifically the rich cultural Kashmiri HOUK SYUN and make it as our earning units.





Human Aid society conduct a series of trainings for its project aspirants throughout the year at its head office Baramulla as well as at their established unit places, wherein the subject experts trained them how they can use modern technology machine at their respective places so that they can run the units well and earn profits for themselves.

Taking forward its steps under women empowerment initiative the projects which were earlier started as Vegetable processing units, in this regard Human Aid Society has managed to conduct a week-long work shop at **SKUAST** Srinagar for the aspirants who are running those units.

In the workshop these aspirants were able to make products like Tomato Puree, Sauce, Fruit Jams, and juices etc. From every Centre, four candidates were selected who get the training. The workshop was conducted by Assistant Professor of SKUAST Dr. Rouf who gave training to the aspirants.

Dr. Farah Joint Director Extension Education SKUAST got highly impressed and said this is her first experience that an NGO is empowering women folk by choosing the field of agriculture and horticulture. She also assured another training program will be conducted which will be fully sponsored by the university, besides every other possible support will be provided as well.

MEETING WITH AUSTRALIAN HIGH COMMISSION AT NEW DELHI: Indicates Success of SAFE project.

A high-level delegation of Human Aid Society called on Australia’s High Commissioner to India **Mr. Barry O’Farrell** at New Delhi on 17th Jan 2023 to discuss the successful outcomes of ‘Sustenance Through Affordable Farming and Entrepreneurship (SAFE) project in which women self -help groups were trained to use modern machinery to dry vegetables and fruits using dehydration method. Mr. Barry O’Farrell hailed the efforts of the Human Aid Society for empowering women with such innovative projects for sustainable farming and entrepreneurship besides assured further support in skill development. Human Aid Society delegation briefed the high Commissioner about past efforts of organization in running skill development and other Humanitarian Aid Programme in collaboration with various National NGOs like Confederation of Indian Industries, (CII), Rajiv Gandhi Foundation New Delhi, Sadbhavna Charitable Trust and International NGO KDF-UK.



PARTICIPATION IN NGOs & OTHER GOVT MEETINGS

On the basis of its credibility and selfless service towards the people, Human Aid Society always attend meetings as organized by National and International NGO's round the year and during the year 2022-2023, Chairman of the organization participated in a meeting as conducted by a Delhi based organization called "**Pariyaas**" on 10th April 2022 at Rajbagh (Srinagar) and he put forward the grievances of the NGO's in front of the panel there and expressed a belief that these grievances should be heard and forwarded to higher authorities. Chairman participated in a meeting as organized by the **UNICEF** on 19th April 2022 at Hotel Solar Residency Srinagar and many top most NGOs of J&K take part in it. The meeting was presided over by the UNICEF Northern head **Miss Maria Kohkar**. During the meeting an alliance was framed where in 5 top most organization got chance to become the Core members of that alliance and Human Aid Society was among one of them.

Chairman Human Aid Society Mr. Bashir Ahmad Mir held an hour-long meeting with **Shri Gagan Sethi** -a renowned social activist of India and Head of **Jan Vikas Organization** at **Ahmedabad** on 13th Feb 2023 in which various points of discussion took place. This meeting happened almost after 15 years and various points were discussed especially the vision of Human Aid Society which

was set at birth time of organization and now the same has been accomplished. The work, achievements and challenges were shared with him.

Human Aid Society also participated in a meeting as it was held on 6th May 2022 at HWVO office Sopore under the Chair of **Chief agricultural officer Baramulla** to share current or emerging opportunities in Agri-sector and exploring possibilities of Joint Programming. CAO Baramulla sought support from Development Organizations for expansion of existing agriculture departmental initiatives in honey, mushroom, high value vegetables, potato seed tuber, summer pea, spice particularly garlic, sweet corn and verme compost to create income and employment opportunities for larger community benefit.

EDUCATION

Education has remained primary focus of Human Aid Society right from its beginning as it has remained our main focus. Educated youth is the main pillar of a nourished society. In our society we see a number of young children who are deprived good education belonging to that very section of society who cannot afford and pursue the same. Human Aid Society identifies such children and every year provides them all the basics needed like that of books, uniforms and bags and all the prerequisites to make sure that these children receive the education and later contribute in making the society more batter. Moreover, organization arranges counseling sessions and exposure trips to boost their confidence and self-esteem. In this regard, Human Aid Society provided assistance to 35 students during this financial year.

In order to felicitate and eulogize the orphans and poor children in view of the auspicious occasion of Eid, Human Aid Society organized an 'Eid Milan' at Dak Bunglow Baramulla wherein sponsored students of the organization participated and interacted with Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP) Baramulla Mr. Rayees Mohammad Bhat, Prof. Irshad Ahmad Wani Ex Director North Kashmir University Camps, Ex Principal GDC Prof Ismail who encouraged these wards and briefed them about the challenges they faced while achieving their goals defying social and economic odds.



EMERGENCY RELIEF AND RESCUE

Human Aid society always taken lead in reaching the places wherein any untoward happen and in this regard this year the organization distributed Cash assistances, Bedding, Utensils and food items among various fire victims of District Baramulla in village PATOOSA Rafiabab on 30th April 2022, Chak-e-Mulgam KRALWETH Kunzer on 28th May 2022, IJARA Boniyar (Uri) on 14th June 2022 in Village, and helped the fire victim families whose residential houses become Ash's and lost their all belongings during the traffic fire incidents and the people of concerned areas hails the timely efforts of Human Aid society in this regard.



RESCUE OPERATIONS DURING ROAD ACCIDENTS

It has been rightly said that social service has no boundary. An unfortunate accident happened at Srinagar- Jammu highway at Nandni Tunnel tube on 17th Dec 2022. While Official team of Human Aid Society was travelling to Jammu. A family car met an accident and all the (5 five) travelers of same family in the car got injured. It is unfortunate that no one among the other traveler's came forward for their help but they just saw and left the spot. Human Aid Society left their purpose and immediately called 1033 Ambulance and took the injured Persons to GMC Jammu even Human Aid society team accompanied them till the close relatives of those injures family didn't arrived as the victim family was from village Nunmai of District Kulgam.

Human Aid Society Members/ Volunteers were fully engaged in performing the Qurbanies on behalf of those people who trust upon Human Aid Society and KDF-UK. WORK EXTENTION FROM KASHMIR TO JAMMU

Human Aid Society has restarted its work from Jammu camp office on Dec 15th as earlier the said camp office was closed due to harsh summer, and in every winter its work is resumed from the said office WEF 15th Dec to 15th of March. Operating the work from camp office means that the people living in the remote areas of Jammu region can also get some help from this organization on humanitarian grounds, and in this regard Human Aid Society Has established a Free Cutting & Tailoring skill center in a far-flung village Ratti Sarie of Sujwaan Jammu by the financial support of KDF-UK wherein 15 young unemployed girls got a chance to get themselves skilled in the said established trade. It is pertinent mentioned here that Human Aid Society has always try to keep administration close to the people so that such places can be paid special attention by the Govt. Keeping to its mission forward the organization invited **Deputy Commissioner Income Tax**

Jammu Mr. Shakeel Ahmad (IRS) and Ex Deputy Director Health Services and present Chairman Municipal Council Baderwah Dr Shaid Mugal for inaugurating the established Skill center at Ratti Sari. Mr Shakeel Ahmed (IRS) while addressing the gathering ensured all kind help for students who want to pursue higher education and competitive exams. "I personally assure you to provide every kind help regarding education and competitive exams for which i will mobilize my all contact because this far off village needs attention. Former Deputy Director Health Dr. Shahid Mogal regretted that this village has remained without any health facility so far but he assured to take up the matter with higher up.

Continuing its combat to eradicate the social evils eating at the core of society, Human Aid Society A (Mother NGO) in collaboration with its partner non-governmental organization (NGOs) Jammu and Kashmir Yateem Foundation, Human Welfare Voluntary organization, GIANTS Group of Baramulla and Karwaan-e- Imdaad organized a daylong seminar on theme ‘Social Reforms and Our Responsibility’ at auditorium of Government Boys Degree College Baramulla on Saturday in north Kashmir’s Baramulla district



While addressing to the audience which include people from cross section of society in jam-packed auditorium, chief guest Former Chief Justice Jammu and Kashmir UT and Ladakh Justice Ali Mohammad Magrey said, “It is collective responsibility of every individual in the society to fight against the social evils and more responsibility lies on the shoulders of parents and religious clerics, teachers and social activists to eradicate the menaces as society is witnessing steep rise in suicide tendencies and drug abuse .”



Deputy Commissioner Baramulla Dr Syed Sehrish Asgar said that stress level high in kids due to studies as we have put them in competition and there is performance pressure on them. “We have to realize that every individual is born with special abilities and capabilities but we put ourselves in competitions of achievers which leads to depression. We must not give space to negative thinking, we have to face and fight the challenges,” she added.
