HUMAN AID SOCIETY INCOLLOBRATION WIH ILTIZAM RELIEF SOCIETY MALAYSIA distributed 100 Food kits at Dak Bunglow Baramulla:

4th August 2023: Human Aid Society played a key role in providing free ration kits to about 100 families living in various far-flung villages of Baramulla district with the financial support of an international social organization, ILTIZAM RELIEF SOCIETY (IRS). The organizations distributed these free 100 ration kits among 73 widows 08 orphans and 19 poorest of poor families. On this occasion, the patron of Human Aid Society. On this occasion the speakers highlighted that we are fully aware that a lot of people were getting monthly old age pensions and widow fund from Department of Social Welfare Govt of J&K and were reducing their burden of their daily expenses but it comes in our notice that due to some unknown reasons, the monthly assistances they get has been delayed by the Govt Social Welfare Department due to which their young children and others are forced to starve. He said that Human Aid Society with the help of its baseline volunteers, identified about one hundred such families who are barely surviving.

State Taxation Officer Mr Showkat Ahmad Shah (KAS) during his address said that I was posted as district Social Welfare officer Baramulla for four years and I am not only aware of the work of social organizations working here but I am also well aware of the difficulties of the people.

Mr Showkat said that as far as the work of the Human Aid Society is concerned, I am myself witness that this organization is totally working on Humanitarian grounds and this was the reason that during my tenure, Human Aid Society was given the title of Mother NGO for the District Baramulla by the then Deputy Commissioner Mr. Dr. G.N itoo sab he added that I also remember the devastating period of Covid-19 when the Humane Society along with other organizations played a key role in reducing the hardship of the people by walking hand in hand with the government especially the district authorities.



HAS PARTICIPATION IN 77th Independence Day:

Human Aid Society Chairman participated in 77th Independence Day as it was celebrated at Wagoora Tehsil Head quarter wherein the BDC Block Wagoora Mr Gh Mohi-u-din Sofi raised the flag. 2023 Winter Aid preparations meeting.

30th August 2023: An important meeting of field level volunteers of Human Aid Society for Rafiabad, Uri, Boniyar and Kindi Baramulla was conveyed by the Chairman of Human Aid Society at its head office Baramulla in regard to take an immediate step in identifying of 250 poorest of poor families who so are facing hard ships during the harsh winters living in their respective areas. The patron, Chairman and Secretary HAS briefed the volunteers that this organisation has requested its international funding NGO ILTIZAM RELIEF SOCIETY(IRS) MALAYSIA during their recent Kashmir visit on 18th August 2023 and loud it that in Kashmir people are facing too much hardships during Chilaikalan and requested the IRS 2 members delegation for their winter Aid Support and IRS delegation assured Human Aid Society Chairman that they will definitely try to convince their CEO for the same. Hence keeping in mind, the fact Human Aid Society Patron, Chairman and Secretary requested their volunteers to help this organisation in identifying the poorest of poor families as soon as possible so that once the organisation get the confirmation from its funding agency (IRS) the winter Aid items will be procured and the same will be distributed among the identified beneficiaries before winter will knock their doors. During the meeting a 2 members volunteer team lead by HASK office assistant Mr Riyaz Ah War

was also constituted by the Chairman for completing the same process in identifying of one hundred (100) families of Machil area of Kupwara District. The volunteers were asked to submit the received beneficiary application forms before 7th of September 2023 so that the requisite budget will be submitted to IRS as per their project set timeline.
