**Encouraging our members make us proud:** 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2024. **Social Commitment:** 14<sup>th</sup> June. A team of Human Aid Society visited Hamam, Markot andDoniwari villages of Rafi Abad to mourn the death of three villagers who lost their lives in a tragicaccident of a mini bus at Pazwalpora Rafi Abad, Dozens were injured in that accident. Human Aid Society team visited the residence of all the deceased and some critically injured patients and sympathized with their families. The team urged the government to ensure that the relief as due shall be provided to the affected families without any delay and cognizance shall be taken regarding the fitness and legality of passenger vehicles.

These students had succeeded with flying colours and had become a source of inspiration and motivation for HAS other enrolled wards. The successful students were given cash awards and Studymaterial, and the event was also attended by their parents who appreciated this dignified way of treating their children.



**Elections of Human Aid Society:** The election process was initiated following a nod given during the last annual meeting held on May 27, and the organization functioned under the Election Commission during this period, with the acting Chairman being the Vice Chairman. The acting Chairman framed an election commission on 5<sup>th</sup> of June 2024 vide his notification **No HASK/Bla/Election/ 808** and published in local newspaper, besides this the commission was temporary provided accommodation in Human Aid Society office complex for smooth running of the said election process.



The Chief Election Commissioner of Human Aid Society while exercising the election process conducted its 1st meeting on **5<sup>th</sup> June 2024 (evening)** and circulated election notification vide No **HASK/Bla/Election/809-11** and published the same in local newspaper Kashmir images Dated **07.06-2024**, besides it the election Commission also created a separate WhatsApp group for updating their information to its all concerned corners. After circulating the election notification 10 (Ten) general body members of Human Aid Society approached the election commission and collected their nomination papers during the prescribed time and submitted the same well on time.

The Election Commission scrutinized all its received nomination paper on 12<sup>th</sup> June 2024 and found only nine (9) candidates eligible while one nomination paper was rejected by the commission, and later on out nine (9) eligible candidates two (2) of them have withdrawn their paper for the post of Executive member and hence only seven (7) nomination papers remain stand for the said election (2 for Chairman post, 5 for executive). The chief Election Commissioner allotted the symbols to all contesting candidates and requested them to run their election campaign under the prescribed guidelines and follow the instructions of the Election Commission.

**On 29<sup>th</sup> June 2024** the elections were held and members have actively participated in this election and used their votes. Voting took place from 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM, allowing 38 general body members the right to vote out of which 29 voted were Polled. The results were declared by the Chief Election Commissioner on the same date, and the newly elected members were subsequently administered the oath of office and awarded winning certificates. The newly elected Chairman, Bashir Ahmad Mir, was given the authority to choose his office bearers, including the Vice Chairman, Treasurer, and Secretary of the organization, with the consent of the members. Additionally, two members will be nominated by the Chairman.
