HAS & IRS Winter Aid Relief for District Bandipora and Baramulla:

10th Nov 2023: In a move to help the poor and needy people Human Aid Society in collaboration with ILTIZAM Relief Society Malaysia completed its 2nd phase of winter aid distribution in Bandipora and Baramulla districts. The distribution process was personally monitored by Mr. Rafiq Ravi ILTIZAM Relief Society Malaysia Project director for India flanked by Chairman Human Aid Society Mr. Bashir Ahmad Mir and Mr GH Mohmmad Lone (Ex CEO) and HASK Senior executive Member Mr Mohammed Sadiq Bhatt in District Bandipora while as in Baramulla District it was monitored by HAS secretary Mr Naseer Ah Rather and Senior GB Member Mr GH Mohi-u-din Ganie.

This winter aid is the part of project sponsored exclusively by ILTIZAM Relief Society Malaysia and they had already agreed to continue it in a bid to help the poverty ridden people in Kashmir.

The phase 1st winter Aid distribution process was early started on 28th Oct 2023 from the far-flung area of Machil and it was a new experience for Human Aid Society to understand the pathetic conditions of people living in these border areas. It is pertinent to mention here that

The local, administration as well as the army especially, 45 RR and Sikh Lie Regiment, Machil Police station, concerned PRIS and BDC of Machil Support was also quite appreciative.



The distribution process in Bandipora and Baramulla was started on 2nd November 2023 from, Tangtari, Sadrakote Balla and on 3rd Nov 2023 it reached to Rafiabad, Boniyaar, Sheeri, Gingle and URI area and it was very special because Mr. Rafiq Bin Ravi Iltizam Relief Society Malaysia project Director for India was himself present with the distribution team police post Fagipora (Rafiabad) also assisted in the process.

The beneficiaries from different villages of Uri area had assembled at Uri town wherein the process of Aid distribution was attended by Dr. Sajad Shafi who at the end thanked Human Aid Society and it's supporting partner Iltizam Relief Society Malaysia for remembering the poor families of this border area in such a difficult time.

On 4th November 2023 the distribution process started from Chandoosa and then, kohlina and Saloosa. In Hygam the team was joined by Mr. Imtiyaz Ahmad President Traders Federation Khoie Hygam along with his team. He thanked Iltizam Relief Society Malaysia and Human Aid Society for this wonderful job and promised to carry this mission forward.

In village Tilgam (patten), the team was received by a veteran, Kashmiri poet writer and Scholar Mr. Fayaz Tilgami who is also the pioneer member of Human Aid Society. Mr Fayaz Tilgami applauded the role of both the organisation and requested to remember his area in future as well since the feel neglected.

On 9th November 2023, the team finally concluded its phase 2nd winter Aid distribution process from Tehsil Baramulla and in phase 1st and phase 2nd the organisations provided it's winter Aid relief to 300 (three hundred) families and distributed provisional items, Rice and Warm Blankets among its selected beneficiaries who were early identified by their volunteers after a proper Door to door survey.

Human Aid Society takes this opportunity to express their gratitude to ILTIZAM Relief Society Malaysia who had taken utmost interest in this project and said that we are highly indebted to them for sending their representative to monitor the whole process. we hope they will further this relationship with Human Aid Society in order to help the poverty ridden people of Kashmir to live a happy and prosperous life.

The organisations also extended their gratitude to common people, Administration, Police Army for their support and salute Human Aid Society members, volunteers and its well-wishers who exerted all their efforts to identify the beneficiaries and then reaching out to them with the relief.
