The team then visited to Ratti Sarrai a remote tribal village of Jammu wherein these organization had already run a skill center at this location and though it was a great challenge for human Aid Society but however by the efforts of its local volunteers made this happen. The trainees of this center had completed their training 6 (six)months diploma course and team was happy to see the progress as some trainees were wearing self-stitched clothes. Mr Khawaja Sahib while felicitating the trainees with certificates applauded the role of Human Aid Society Kashmir & KDF-UK He emphasized on continuity of this skill development programme and

requested both the organizations to extend the various initiatives of social work to Poonch and Rajouri area where people are poor and are unskilled. He offered his support to peruse such initiatives and promised to utilize the service of many of his friends to unravel the dream of prosperity. On this occasion A poor trainees girl resident of village Ratti Sarrai whose father is suffering from Skin cancer since from last three years was given a marriage assistance **cash cheque of Rs Twenty thousands (20000) and a tailoring sewing Kit** including other tool items on behalf of KDF -UK.

Human Aid Society Participation in one day outreach program on combating misuse of Non-Profit Organizations for terror financing at Srinagar.



18th oct 2023. CID Wing of J&K Police organized a daylong outreach program on combating misuse of vulnerable Non-Profit Organizations (NPOs) for terror financing (TF) at PCR Kashmir today jointly with MHA, GOI. The purpose behind the program was to create awareness among the office bearers of different NPOs of Kashmir valley against their potential misuse for terror financing by various terrorist organizations based in J&K or elsewhere as has been observed in some cases in recent past.

About 50 functionaries of different Kashmir based NPOs participated in the program, which was co-chaired by Omprakash Singh, JDD, MHA New Delhi and Farooq Qaiser, SSP (FIU) CID Hqrs J&K, in which experts from MHA, interacted with the participants over wide range of topics including FATF provisions vis-a-viz NPOs, Income Tax provisions related to charitable organizations, misuse of NPOs for terror financing etc.
